Hannahs at Seale-Hayne Summer of Art – Urban Takeover

Deadline – 9am, 29th April 2013

Hannahs at Seale-Hayne (just outside Newton Abbot) is preparing for a metropolitan invasion, when **Summer of Art – The Urban Takeover** brings the creative heart of the city to the Devon countryside (15th June - 26th August 2013). Building on our relationship with some of the most respected galleries in the UK, the gallery will feature a street art exhibition on loan from the V&A, including iconic pieces by the likes of Banksy, Blek le rat, Jamie Hewlett, Pure Evil and D'face. Alongside this we are offering commissions for artists working in this field. In addition to a large installation in the gallery itself, there are opportunities for artists to create work around the 90 acre site.

Opportunities and fees

1. Gallery commission (temporary) – the gallery at Hannahs will, in part, house a selection of works from the V&A's Street Art Collection. The exhibition has been designed so that the artworks will be at one end and there is another space (approx half of the overall gallery), which has been allocated for an artist to take over entirely to create something fantastic, it must have a real wow factor as you walk into the space. The space available for this commission measures @63m² and photos can be seen on the tumblr link below. The commission here must be completed between 1st - 9th June 2013. £1150 is available which must include all fees, materials and expenses (excluding accommodation which is provided if required – see below).
2. 2 x separate commissions are available across the 90 acre site at Hannahs. These can be done at any time between 15th - 29th June 2013 - the idea for these is that the public are able to see the artists at work and they are intended to be semi-permanent. The artist is welcome to choose their own location from a bank of options which can be seen on the link below.

There is a fee available of £600 per commission which must include all fees, materials and expenses (excluding accommodation which is provided if required – see below).

3. Finally, if you are a community group who would like to get involved, please get in touch! We may be able to offer you a space to use to create work over the summer.

- Accommodation on a bed and breakfast basis is available upon request for all successful applicants (Opportunities 1 & 2). This will be in the former accommodation unit on site at Hannahs and provided free of charge in addition to the fees above.
